It has been a special week for us at Suzanne Aubert as we have finished the term with our Holy Week remembrance. Each day we witnessed a different event in Jesus' journey to the cross. Each event was prepared as a liturgical dramatisation by our different teams. On Monday, our Year 1-2 Hikurangi learners retold the story of Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday. On Tuesday, our leadership team re-enacted the moment that Jesus washed the feet of his disciples. On Wednesday, our Year 3-4 Mangatawa learners shared the narrative of Jesus' Last Supper meal with his disciples. Holy Week concluded on Thursday, when our Year 5-6 Kopukairoa learners retold Jesus' final moments from his condemnation to his death and burial through the 14 Stations of the Cross. Thank you to all our staff and learners for the preparation and organisation of these liturgies in what was a very prayerful and reflective week. We are very proud of you all. Thank you also to Ruth Dunne and Kate Magill who supported costume making to help make it truly authentic! Each of these liturgies were video recorded and will be shared with the community in the coming days on our school YouTube channel.

COVID UPDATE

As you will be aware, the country shifted to the Orange Setting in the Covid Traffic Light Framework at midnight on Wednesday 13th April. This brings significant easing of restrictions for schools. These include the following key changes:
